- Each student will participate in unmounted horsemanship activities as well as mounted riding lessons
- The half-day program includes hands-on activities on the ground which will be reinforced in the saddle as the students learn riding skills
- Multisensory input provided by the horses promotes enthusiasm towards reading skills, self-confidence, increased focus, and confidence among peers
- Bring your own lunch and picnic on the grounds after camp
- Groups must provide transportation and chaperones. Equest will provide certified instructors, horses, tack, helmet rentals, and program volunteers for additional support.
- Targeted literacy skills may include:
 - Identifying nouns, verbs, and adjectives
 - Rhyming
 - Increasing vocabulary
 - Capitalization
 - Initial/Final sounds
